REGISTRATION – GENERAL INFORMATION

- Students are required to use [insideND](#) for registration.
- Check the day and time of your registration by following this path on [insideND](#) : “Student Academic” tab; to “Student Academic Services” channel; to the “Registration (DART)” link; and select “Registration Status and Holds”.
- Check for any registration “Holds” prior to registration at “Registration Status and Holds”.
- You may contact the Office of the Registrar by e-mail at dart@nd.edu or by phone at 574-631-7043.
- To search for classes being offered, follow this path on [insideND](#) : “Student Academic” tab; to “Student Academic Services” channel; and select “Class Search”.

REGISTRATION PIN

- Students **at the main campus** (and those returning from a leave of absence) will receive their PIN information from the department of their declared first major or, from their college academic advisor if no major has been declared. All **First Year students** will receive their PIN information from their First Year Advisors.
- The following exceptions will use six zeros (000000) as their PIN:
 - * Students **returning** to the main campus from currently attending a Notre Dame off-campus program.
 - * Students **going** to study in Fremantle, Australia; Puebla, Mexico; or Washington D.C
 - * Students **studying** in the Rome Architecture Program.
 - * Students **going** to study in the undergraduate London Program. They will also receive separate instructions.
- The following students will have no PIN required:
 - * Saint Mary’s College students, who are registering for classes at Notre Dame.
 - * University of Notre Dame Employees who are registering for classes.
 - * Newly admitted students for the Spring 2010 semester.
 - * Law students – except first year Law students, who do not register on DART.

REGISTRATION DART TIME

- The DART registration time indicates when a student can begin registering for classes.
- **All DART registration times are listed using local South Bend times.**
- Students can check their DART registration time information by following this path on [insideND](#) : “Student Academic” tab; to “Student Academic Services” channel; to the “Registration (DART)” link; and select “Registration Status and Holds”.
- Any registration “Hold” information can also be found on “Registration Status and Holds”.
- The DART registration is active through January 20, 2010, the seventh class day of the semester.
(With the following exceptions: First Year students, students going to study in London, and all Law students.)
- **All Students** will register according to their DART registration time.
- Schedule for Spring 2010 DART registration start times, at the main campus and for students returning to the main campus:
 - Seniors** – November 16 and 17
 - Graduate School, Law School, and Master of Nonprofit Administration** – November 18
(Law School DART registration time expires on January 15, 2010.)
 - Juniors** – November 19 and 20
 - Sophomores** – November 23 and 24
 - Freshmen (First Year students)** – November 30 and December 1
(Freshmen DART registration time expires on December 3. DART will reopen January 12 and 13, during the student’s PE class time, for the PE Activities registration.)
 - Non-degree students** – December 2
 - Students** who will be **going** to Fremantle, Australia; Puebla, Mexico; or Washington D.C. – December 2
 - Students going** to the undergraduate London Program – will receive separate instructions for January registration
 - Students returning from a leave of absence** will follow the instructions for continuing students
 - Employees** – January 11
- Students **going** to off-campus programs (domestic or overseas) will not register for their classes through DART. Please contact the Office of International Studies.
The exceptions are:
 - * Students **going** to study in Fremantle, Australia; Puebla, Mexico; or Washington D.C. – December 2
 - * Students **studying in the Rome Architecture Program** – November 19
 - * Students **going** to study in the undergraduate London Program. – will receive separate instructions for January registration.
