## University of Notre Dame Undergraduate Programs

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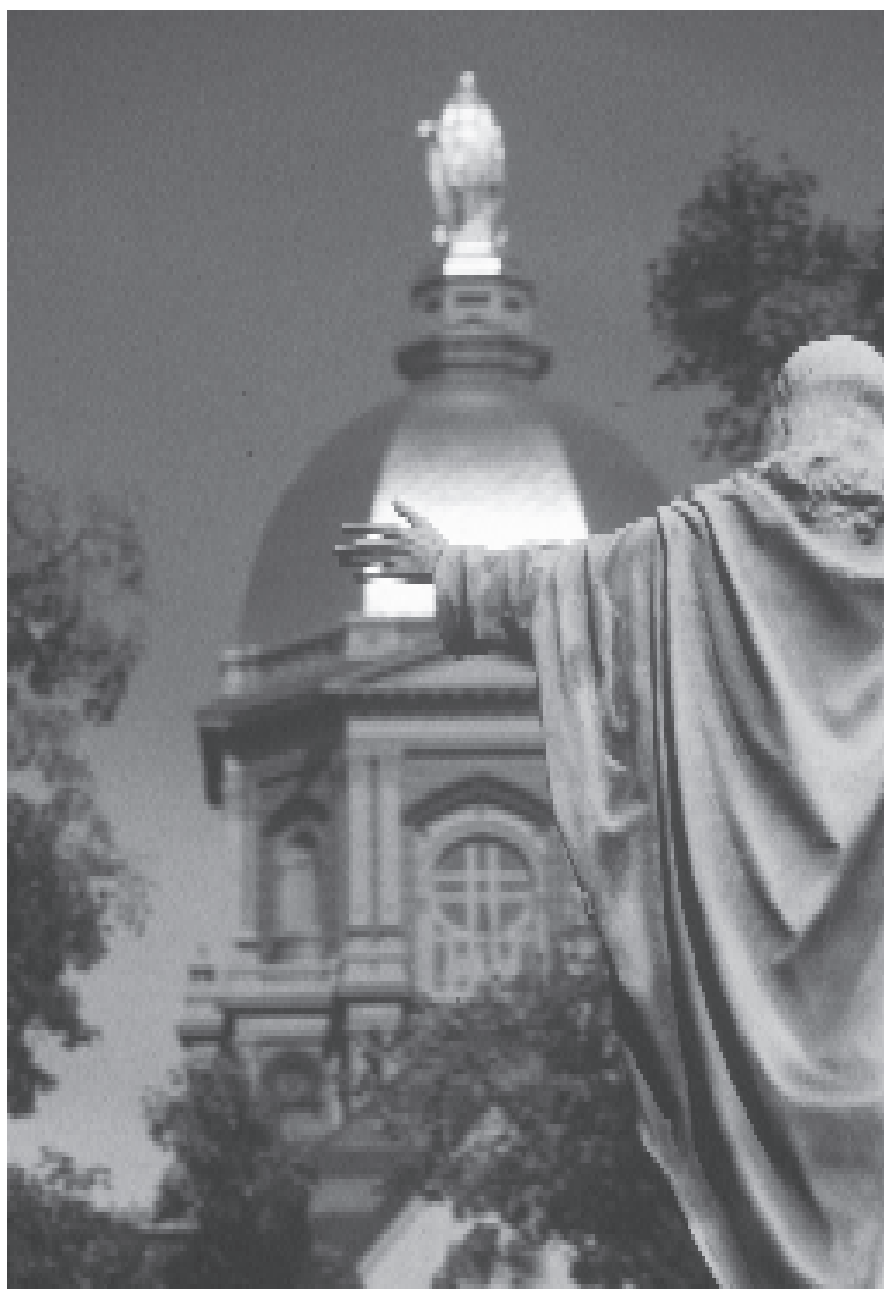
